• After multiple assessments, the final test consisted of 97 modules covering all topics that students learned throughout the CQS 111 course. This includes navigational tools, formatting options, formulas, tables, charts and PivotTables/PivotCharts. Results showed that 91% received a 90 or higher and 94% with an 80 or higher versus significantly lower scores before using ExPrep.

Problem

Professor John MacDonald previously used another product as a training and testing tool for his class. However, he found the program to be inefficient and ineffective as students struggled to grasp different Excel topics.

Solution

Result
